In this piece, the cello takes the role of the protagonist, longing to be near the river; and the piano, as the river, performs in a flowing manner.

Bar 25:

The fluid lines drawn in the score merely act as a rough guide for the performer regarding register. This section is quasi-improvised, and the pianist should use the stated pitches as a base point from which to infuse a flowing and varied sense of rhythm. This section of the work is dream like, and should be performed with a sense of transparency.
