Dreamer:1 is the first instalment of a set of short pieces based on the collected dreams of many friends and kind strangers.

This short, fun piece provides a start to the series where I first introduce some Hypnagogic dreams, which are the first kind of dreams you have upon falling asleep, the entire collection of pieces will mirror the journey through sleep.

Performer notes:

The ever bubbling '*num num num*' found throughout this piece represents neuron's firing in the brain as we sleep, creating our dreams. As the ensemble you represent this brain, and are seen in this context as the creator of, and the participant in, the dreams. Please note that the '*num num num*' text is always meant to be sung with little 'daylight' in the vowel, closing to the 'm' quickly. This text should always be sung in a light a bubbling manner. When there are indications to add weight to the piece, this applies only to the main text. Eg. In the 'CLOUD' section, the 'with more intensity' refers to the performance of the text/narrative.
